



Rhyming Egg Hunt

Ahead of time, print and cut out the attached eggs. Keep one egg from each rhyme family. Hide the rest around your house or garden, ready for an egg hunt!

Make a large circle from yarn or a hula hoop for **each** rhyme family – These are your “home circles”.

Remember the eggs you kept? Place one inside each of the circles, ready for your child to add rhyming eggs.

The egg hunt begins! As your child finds an egg, have them return to the home circles and match the egg to the correct rhyming circle!
